About Seminar and Workshop

Laboratories are believed to be the fundamental source of scientific evidence, critical for clinical research and decision making in clinical diagnostics and patient care. It reveals the essence of inculcating best laboratory practice among students, the young scientists of next generation, which aids in the promotion of research activities associated with diverse fields. Educating the students with strong laboratory practices are necessary to ensure reliable test results that lead to appropriate diagnosis and treatment. In particular, knowledge on quality management practices such as standard operating procedures are most vital, as they serve as the key tools to ensure high quality and consistent laboratory testing. Inappropriate knowledge on laboratory practice may also sometime cause deleterious effects which include breakage of equipment, poor sanitation in facilities, routing and reporting confusion, and, in the worst case scenario, increased health risk.

Good laboratory practice (GLP) is a quality system that covers the organizational process and the conditions under which non-clinical laboratory studies are planned, performed, monitored, recorded, archived and reported.

Aim of the GLP is to promote the generation of valid, high quality test data and latter will be applied in the clinical trials based on their effect (beneficial or adverse). While applying in the clinical studies, complying the international ethical and scientific quality standard should be assured to acquire credible and accurate results. Hence the output is the Good Clinical Practice (GCP), produce effective results that are consistent, auditable and repeatable. The combination of GLP and GCP constitutes the Good Clinical Laboratory Practice (GCLP) which encompass all aspects of clinical trial laboratory operations.

Research Laboratories complying the GCLP standards will establish an effective research output that can enhance the knowledge on biomedical fields and research quality.

Few examples for GCLP include vaccination development, invention of diagnostic markers for various pathophysiological condition, development of new techniques for disease management / treatment.

Hence, the aim of the conference is to share the vision among the next generation scientists in the context of significance of laboratory practices and their applications in the clinical diagnosis domain.
